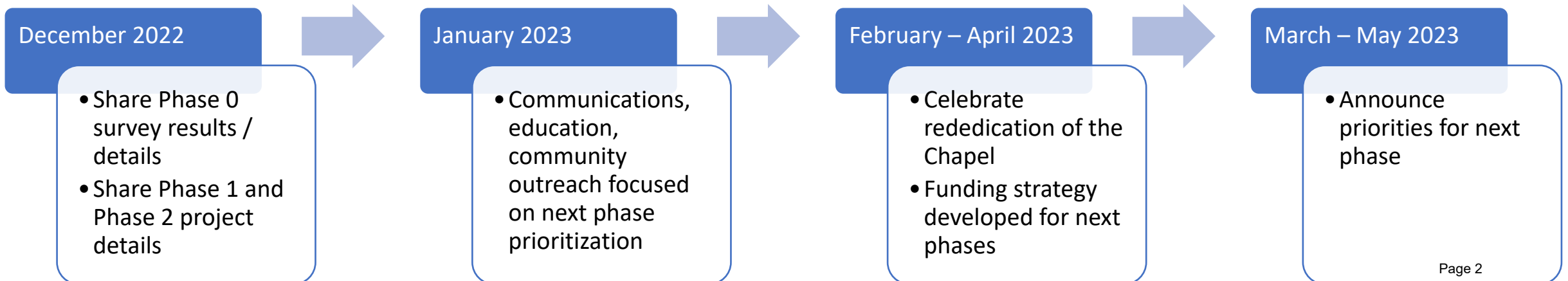

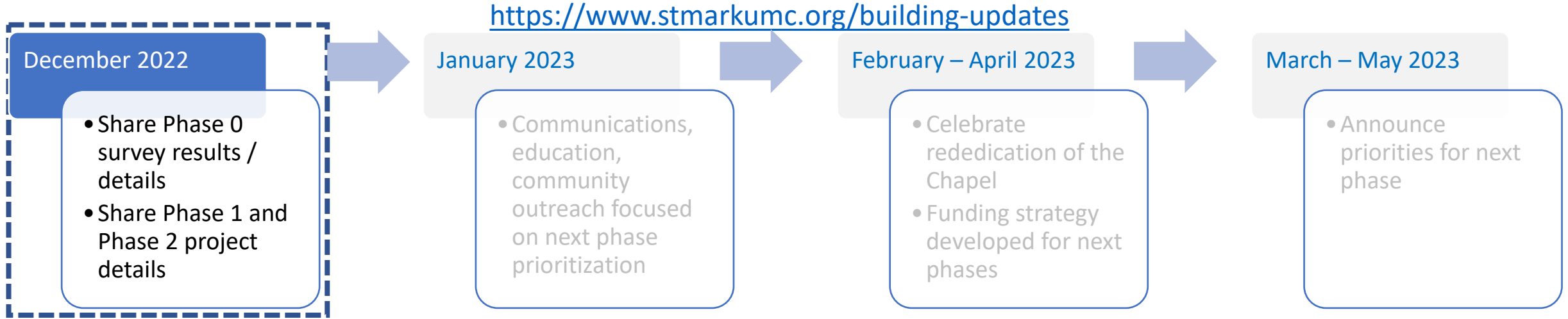
The Endurability Committee is approaching the end of their studies and project recommendations for Saint Mark. The Endurability Committee was originally charged with developing a plan to ensure our buildings are watertight, to repair water damage to interiors, to connect our 2nd floor to the new parking deck, and to upgrade infrastructure as necessary.

We will kick off 2023 with active community engagement and educational sessions in January and February. The work of the Endurability Committee has created a multi-year facilities improvement roadmap which will be managed and executed as funding is available – a significant portion of which is in-hand from our property sale.

The schedule below outlines the community engagement process for the next few months:



Prioritization for Saint Mark Facility Investments



In 2021, an invitation to complete a facility survey was provided to the community.

The Church Council and Endurability Committee have reviewed and compared the 2021 community survey results with consulting guidance received as part of the Endurability Committee’s work. There are many intersections, and all community input will have a place in the facility roadmap.

The following pages provide a thematic summary of the Phase 0 Community Survey. Appendix A includes details of all comments to be sure no contributing thoughts are lost in this process. With the completion of Phases 1 and 2, we will be making decisions on Phase 3 and future phase prioritization and funding needs. The Church Council reviewed a full study compilation and recommendations from the Endurability Committee in December, and you will receive notifications for opportunities to engage in conversations with the Church Council and Endurability Committee members starting in January. We hope the following pages will be helpful by providing an understanding of the thoughts of the community.

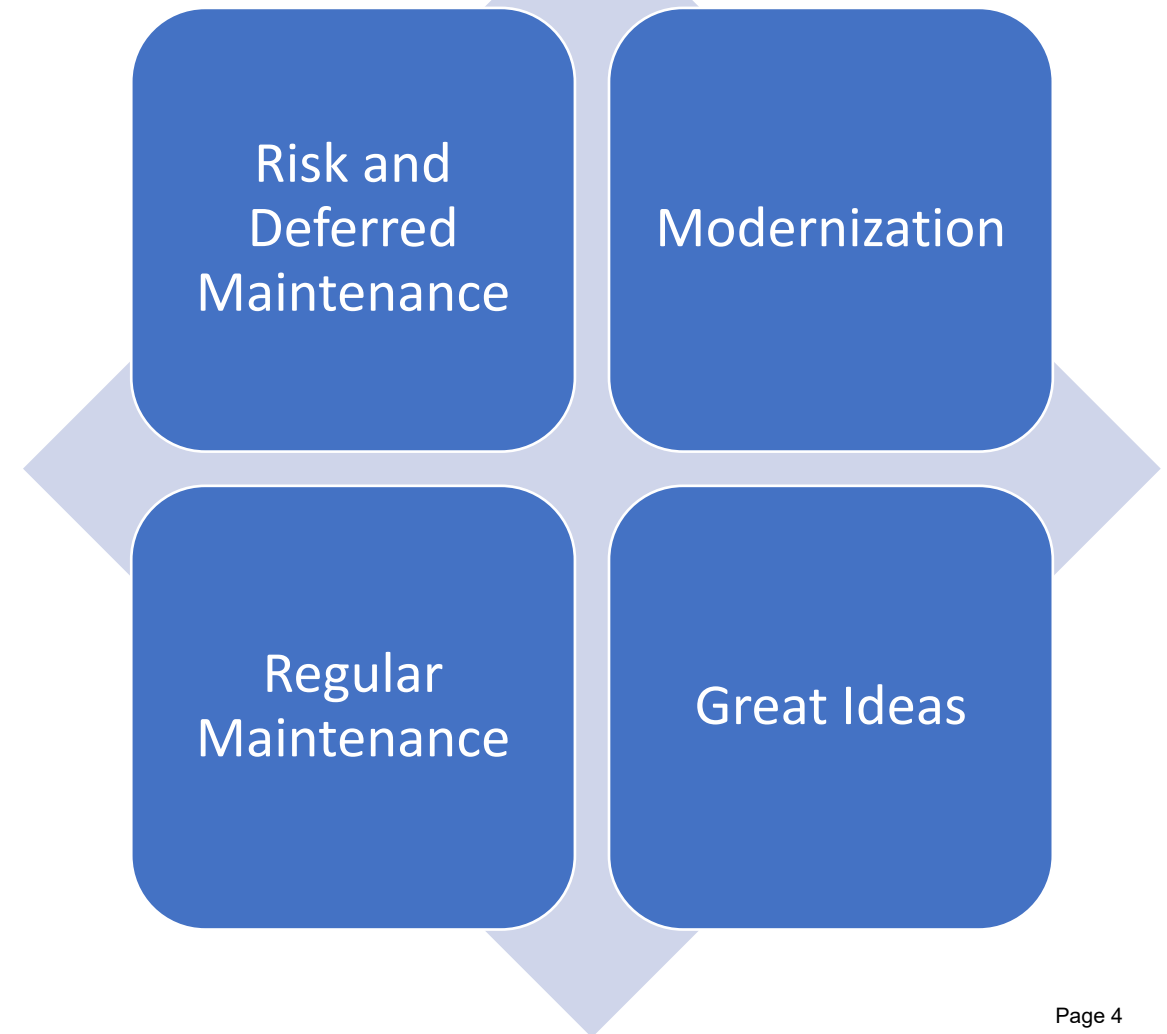
